# PARENTS' SAFER PARKING CHARTER

The Junior Safety Officers and school council at Frodsham Weaver Vale Primary School have constructed a Safer Parking Charter. They want everyone who drives to the School to sign up to the following Parking Charter to help keep everyone safe and improve the quality of life for all those within the school environment. Please remember Road Safety is everyone's responsibility.

I hereby agree to abide by the guidelines outlined within the Safe Parking Charter. By signing up to this charter you agree to:

- **Respect Our Neighbours** – We would like you to respect the other people in this environment.
- **Double parking** – Please do not drop off in the middle of the road!! Other people need to get through including fire and police.
- **Parking considerably** – Please check your surroundings before parking. Think about where you are parking.
- **Parking on corners/junctions** – If you park on junctions or corners pedestrians and people with buggies will be in a blind spot, which makes it more difficult and dangerous to cross because you will have to go on the road.
- **Parking on the Grass** – We would like you to not park on the grass because people might not be able to get through, you might damage the grass, or you could get stuck!

- **Parking in front of Driveways** – we would like you to not park over driveways because people living there will not be able to get out. This would make them upset and stressed.
- **Use the Car Park** – We would like you to park in the car park next to the park and walk the last part to school. It can keep us healthy and it's better than blocking the paths and grass.
- **Parking on Pavements** – Please don't park on pavements, people won't be able to get through. Especially people with buggies.
- **School Keep Clear Zig Zags** – Don't park on the keep clear lines. Children won't be able to get through. Everybody needs to be safe.
- **Double yellow lines** – It is illegal to park on double yellow lines. They are there to keep us all safe. You can get a ticket from the police.

To forward any concerns regarding dangerous parking and road safety in the school environment to the Head teacher or a Governor, who can then take appropriate action.
